Kingston – originally named Eastlake

Kingston was the main shopping centre from 1925 well into post World War II years. JB Young bought the first block and sadly today the corner where his store stood has been changed and no plaque marks the name or the site. JB Young was a household word in Canberra.

Lena May Abraham died on 3rd March 1973 and is buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery.

ADAMS, Margaret, Rebecca, George & Jack hd, hd, master butcher & butcher

George Thomas Adams (the above George in the 1935 electoral roll has *George Raphael Adams*) of 12 Early Street Queanbeyan paid for the graves in the RC section of Woden Cemetery for Margaret Emily Adams who died on 19th May 1953 aged 65 and George R B Adams who died on 27th October 1956 aged 65 years. Both lived at 12 Early Street Queanbeyan.

ARBUCKLE, Elizabeth & John hd & hairdresser (lived at Westlake from c1924 to around 1926)

BANKS, Una & Joseph hd & labourer

BARTLETT, Nathaniel bootmaker

Nathaniel Henry Bartlett died 16th September 1982 and is buried in Gungahlin Cemetery in the ex-servicemen's section.

BOLLER, Charles & Gertrude hd & clerk

St John's Churchyard by Jean Salisbury - Charles Francis Boller married Gertrude Jagers. The couple had three children. Charles died on 19th June 1936 aged 62. He is buried in St John's church cemetery in Reid ACT. Buried next to Charles is his father-in-law, George Herbert Jagers who at the time of his death on 8th February 1942 was aged 88 years. He was the son of John Jagers - farmer - and Mary. He was born at Brogo in 1853. He married Martha Haigh in 1878 and the couple had 13 children.

BOYD, Edith & William c/o S O Taylor hd & labourer

BRITON, Mary & Robert hd & glazier

La Mode BURTON, Stanley bricklayer Stanley Francis Burton of 6 Causeway (1946) paid for the grave of Mrs Rosie Jane Burton of 11 Bourke Crescent Kingston who died on 29th June 1946 aged 67 years. She is buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery.

CALLAGHAN, Edith & David hd & survey foreman

David James Callaghan was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery on 28th August 1948. He died on 5th July 1943 and was 56 years of age. His address at the time of his death was 52 Kennedy Street Kingston. Edith Marion Callaghan died on 1st July 1990 and is buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery. Ross Harold Callaghan was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery and died on 3rd July 1948 aged 56. His address was 73 Causeway. Ross and David Callaghan graves were paid by James McAppion of 73 Causeway. A note in the August 1948 portion of the Woden Cemetery Register notes the burial in the RC Section of the cemetery of David James Callaghan.

CAMERON, Ida & Alexander hd & labourer Alexander Rankin Cameron died on 12th July 1985 and is buried in the ex-servicemen's section of the Woden Cemetery.

DAVIS, Minnie & Arthur hd & carpenter Arthur Frederick Davis was buried in the Methodist Section of Woden Cemetery on 2nd June 1969. Minnie Hilda Davis died on 8th June 1973 and is buried in the next grave. The graves have headstone information that give the following information - Minnie Hilda Davis was in her eightieth year and was born into a pioneer family in the Blue Mountains. She came to Canberra in 1927. Her husband Arthur F Davis died 30th May 1969 aged 80.

(De Smet's are an old Canberra family who lived at Duntroon)

ELLIOTT, Lucy & Joseph hd & ---

Lucy Emily Elliott was buried in the Methodist section of Woden Cemetery on 21st July 1967. In the same grave is Joseph Mitchell Elliott who was buried on 15th September 1950. Joseph was 69 at the time of his death on the 14th September 1950. Buried in the next grave is Alice Brittain who died 1st July, 1946 aged 83. Her grave was paid by Lucy Emily Elliott whose address was 18 Telopea Park Kingston.

FULTON, Jean & Edgar hd & draper
Edgar Glendenning Fulton bought the grave for Edgar John Fulton who was 77 at the time of his death on 13th May 1943. He was buried in the Anglican section of Woden Cemetery on 14th May 1943. At the time of his death he lived 5 Forrest Flats, Forrest. On the 28th October 1944 Jean Reid was buried in the grave next to Edgar John Fulton. She was 70 years of age at the time of her death of the 26th October 1944.

GEE, Eileen & William hd & salesman
Eileen Mary Gee died on 2nd September 1977 and was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery.

GOODWIN, John blacksmith
John Goodwin died on 7th April 1975 and was buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery.

GREGORY, Annie & Walter hd & kitchenman
Annie Lee Gregory was buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery on 26th July 1965 and Walter Humber Gregory was buried in another section of the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery on 25th June 1956. He died on 23rd June 1956 and was 56 years of age at the time of his death. His address at that time was 14 Causeway and his grave was paid by Mrs Annie Lee Gregory of the same address.

GRINSDALE, Edna & John hd & clerk
John Frederick Grinsdale was buried in the ex-servicemen's section of the Woden Cemetery on 27th January 1948. He died on the 25th January and his grave was paid by the RSS&AILA ACT Branch. John Grinsdale was 49 at the time of his death and lived at 97 Canberra Avenue Griffith. Clifford Wiley c/o F Grinsdale Canberra Avenue Griffith (1943) paid for the grave in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery for Peter John Wylie who died on 30th October 1943 aged 2 days. (This family may have shared a house with the Grinsdale family? It was common during World War II for this to happen.)

HALL, Clare hd c/o Mrs Hobbs

HAMMOND, Catherine, Mary Jack, William & William hd, saloon manager, labourer & labourer

Catherine Hammond died on 3rd May, 1948 and her grave costs were paid of William Patrick Hammond. Catherine was 77 years of age at the time of her death. She is buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery. William Pitt Hammond lived at 36

Doonkuna Street at the time of his death on 7th February, 1947. He was buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery. His grave was paid by William Patrick Hammond who was buried in the ex-servicemen's section of Woden Cemetery on 18th May 1963. Mary Ellen Hammond died on 27th April 1978 and was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery. Jack Hammond was buried in the ex-servicemen's section of Woden Cemetery on 5th September 1960. William Patrick Hammond of 59 Leichhardt Street Kingston paid for the grave in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery for Catherine Hammond of 77 Doonkuna Street Reid who died on 3rd May, 1948 aged 77 years.

HARRIS, Florence & Cecil hd & bus inspector
Florence Blanche Harris was buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery on 12th June 1977. In the next grave Cecil Richard Harris was buried on 20th March 1957.

HARRISON, Esther & John hd & haulage contractor

Esther (spelt Ester on burial register) Mary Harrison was buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery. She died on 2nd August 1953 and was 55 years of age at the time of her death. Her address then was 31 Dawes Street Kingston. Her grave and that of the next one for John Harrison was paid by Patricia May Edlington of 31 Dawes Street Kingston. John Harrington died on 24th September 1953 aged 61 years.

HAYS, Elsie Vera, Lavinia & John hd, typist & electrician
St John's churchyard by Jean Salisbury records burials in the church cemetery. One record is of the death of Lavinia Metcalf, daughter of Walter Bailey and Lavinia Metcalf Bailey. She was born in Tasmania and married there to Joseph Pridmore. She had two children Walter & Elsie (Mrs Hays). She lived with her daughter in Kingston where she died on the 16th May 1929 aged 63 years. Buried with her is her grandson David John Hays 1928-1936.

HICKLING, Nellie & Albert hd & fireman
Albert Hickling died on 23rd May 1952 aged 60 years. His address was 5 Jardine Street Kingston and his grave in the Returned Soldiers Section of Woden Cemetery was paid by the RSS&AILA.

6/16 HILL, Violet & Arthur hd & printer
Arthur Hill of 44 Kennedy Street Kingston (1956) died on 27th February 1956 aged 64. His grave in the Anglican section of Woden Cemetery was paid by Keith Arthur Hill of 9 Barrallier Street Griffith.

HILL, Eileen & Reuben hd & fruiter
Eileen Eva May Hill died on 26th March 1978 and was buried in the Presbyterian Section of Woden Cemetery. In the same grave is Reuben Hill who was

buried on 30th November, 1963. Reuben was 73 years of age. In the next grave is Geoffrey Hill who was 16 years of age at the time of his death on 10th January 1938. *St John's Churchyard* by Jean Salisbury has information on Zebulan Hill who died on 5th April 1930 aged 85 years and is buried in St John's church cemetery in Reid ACT. He came to Canberra in 1917 to live with his son Reuben. He wife Agnes had died and the couple had lived in Victoria. Reuben Hill of 21 Lockyer Street at the time of his death died on 28th November 1963. He was 73 years of age.

HOBBS, Stella & Arthur hd & labourer
St John's Churchyard by Jean Salisbury - Several of the Hobbs family are buried in St John's Cemetery in Reid ACT. They include Colin Frederick Hobbs, son of Arthur Oswald Hobbs and Stella Isabel Hobbs. Colin was accidentally killed on 3rd July 1937 by a fall of earth on the banks of the Molonglo River. He was 13 years of age.

HUGHES, Veronica, Cecil & John hd, clothier & storekeeper
Cecil John Hughes died on 8th September 1973 and is buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery. John Thomas Hughes was buried in another section of the RC Section of Woden Cemetery on 20th March 1951. Cecil John Hughes of Kennedy Street Kingston paid for the grave in the RC section of Woden Cemetery for John Thomas Hughes who died on 27th March 1951.

Mrs O M Lewis paid for the grave in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery for Sarah Jane Bowers who died on 27th March 1938 aged 83.

Elizabeth McKinstry was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery on 8th June 1968. William James McKinstry was 76 at the time of his death on 1st April 1956. His grave was bought by Patrick William McKinstry of 9 Leichhardt Street Kingston.

Jack Gordon Majura Mayo was buried in the ex-servicemen's section of the Woden Cemetery on 23rd September 1969. Sarah Jane Mayo nee Bolton was born at Carwoola and was baptised in 1869. She married Thomas Mayo at St John's in 1908 and their son Jack Gordon Majura Mayo was baptised there in 1908. She died in her home in Eyre Street Kingston on 21st October 1938 aged 69.

William John Mitchell was buried in the ex-servicemen's section of Woden Cemetery on 28th September 1956. *St John's Churchyard* by Jean Salisbury notes that Isabella Mitchell is buried in St John's Cemetery in the same grave as her mother. The information in the book also states that Isabella Alder was born in Aberdeen Scotland, daughter of William and Isabella Alder nee Adams. She came to Australia in 1920 and married William John Mitchell, electrician and lived in 39 Giles Street, Kingston. She died on 18th August 1951 aged 63 years. Isabella Alder is buried in St John's Cemetery. She was living with her son-in-law E Bailey in Wentworth Avenue at the time of her death on 12th June 1933 aged 80 years.

Alfred Milton was buried in the ex-servicemen's section of the Woden Cemetery on 25th May 1960. Effie Maria Milton was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery on 13th December 1957. She died on 11th December 1957 aged 62 years. Her grave was paid by Alfred James Milton of 8 Kennedy Street Kingston.

Clive Harold Rose was buried in the ex-servicemen's section of Woden Cemetery on 3rd January 1941. He died on the 2nd January was 50 years of age and his address was given as Bougainville Street Manuka. His grave was paid by A D'Arcy.

ROWE, Alice & Roy hd & supervisor
Roy Rowe died on 15th November 1973 and was buried in the Presbyterian Section of Woden Cemetery. Buried in the next grave is Alice Rowe who died on 9th December 1954. She was 65 years of age and her address at the time of her death was 50 Arthur Circle Canberra. Her grave was paid by R Rowe of the same address.

St John's churchyard by Jean Salisbury records burials in the church cemetery. The following is stated about Eliza Smith who is buried in the church cemetery with her son William John Smith. Eliza was the daughter of Levi and Frances Plummer (nee Guthridge) of Weetangera. She married Matthew Smith in 1879 and the couple had six children. She died on 24th December 1937 aged 77 years.

There is in the cemetery lists another Percy Reginald Tucker who was buried in the Methodist Section of Woden Cemetery on 5th July 1954. Buried in the next grave is Amy Laura Tucker who was buried on 14th August 1940. This grave was bought by Percy Tucker of 31 Causeway and Amy Laura Tucker was 69 years of age at time of death. These graves have tombstones which give the following information - Amy Laura Tucker died on 12th August 1940 aged 68 and Percy died on 1st July 1954 aged 78.

St John's churchyard by Jean Salisbury records burials in the church cemetery and documents the death and burial of David Fraser McFarlane, son of Edith and David who died on the 9th August 1931 aged 26 hours.

RICHARDSON, Ruth dressmaker
Ruth Richardson died on 2nd October 1974 and is buried in the Seventh Day Adventist Section of Woden Cemetery.

2 ROBERTS, Ellen hd

St John's Churchyard by Jean Salisbury notes the burial of Margaret Janet Murray, wife of AK Murray who founded Canberra's first newspaper, *The Federal Capital Pioneer* published between 1924 and August 1926. She lived at Sturtville, Eastlake. She died in Sydney on 4th September 1927 aged 55.

Also buried in St John's Cemetery is Mary Veronica Murray (nee Stewart), wife of Donald Murray, dairyfarmer. The couple married in Scotland. The couple who had seven children came to Australia in 1914 and by the 1930s they lived at Dairy Block 3, Mill Flat. Mary died on 10th October 1933 aged 56. Donald Murray died on 8th June, 1944.

Leslie Garnet Lea died on 29th May 1972 and was buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery. Buried in the same grave is Vera Lea who died on 17th December 1985.

John George Baker died 25th January 1966 and is buried in the ex-servicemen's section of Woden Cemetery.

In 1942 Mrs Margaret Gladys Kelly lived in No 2 Power House Cottage. She paid for the grave in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery for Arthur James Kelly of the same address who died on 3rd March 1942 aged 51 years. In 1935 the family lived in Molonglo. On 7th October 1942 Mrs Margaret Gladys Kelly of No 2 Power House Cottages paid for the grave in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery for Margaret Kelly aged 10 months.

TELOPEA PARK/WARATAH PARKWAY, KINGSTON 1935

The first name was Waratah Parkway then changed to Telopea Park.

ADAMS, Talbot butcher
Talbot Leonard Adams was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery on 28th October 1961. He paid for the grave in the Presbyterian Section of Woden Cemetery for Jessie Sophia Adams who died on 28th April 1949 aged 41 years. Talbot Adams address was 20 Telopea Park, Barton.

BRITTAIN, Alice hd
Alice Jane Brittain was buried in the Methodist Section of Woden Cemetery on 2nd July 1946. She died on the 1st and her grave was bought by Lucy Emily Elliott of 18 Telopea Park, Kingston. Alice was 83 years old at the time of her death.

Percy Douglas was a well known character of early Canberra. He lived for a time at Briar Farm and came to the area sometime in the teen years. The following information has been provided by Brenda Hennessy (nee Stephenson). *My grandmother Clara Stephenson (Barugh) was born in Beverley in Yorkshire. Clara was an excellent pianist and joined with many other women in the United Kingdom to raise money for a statue of Prince Albert after his death. Queen Victoria wrote to her to thank her for doing so. Clara married my grandfather George Herbert Stephenson and lived with him in Cairo for most of her life. Clara spent the last years of her life in Canberra. She died in 1935 and is buried in the graveyard of St John's Church Canberra.*

My father Harold Stephenson was born in London in 1896. He grew up in Cairo where his father was a chemist. He returned to England in 1914 in order to attend University but joined the British Army and served in the 2nd Battalion Grenadier Guards until he was discharged in 1919. He migrated to Australia and was granted a Soldier Settlement Block near Maleny in Queensland but eventually walked off the land as it did not provide him with a living. He moved to Canberra in the mid 1920's and joined the Fire Brigade and served with them for 33 years. He married Ethel Ensor in 1930 and they raised 5 children while Harold worked at Manuka Fire Station. He was a member of The Lady Gowrie Services Club and the Ex Guards Association. Harold died in Wollongong in 1981 and his ashes are interred next to his mother's grave in St John's Churchyard.

My mother Ethel Marjorie Stephenson (Ensor) was born in Winton Queensland in 1906. She came to Canberra in the late 1920's and commenced training as a nurse at Canberra Hospital. After her marriage she devoted her time to raising her children. Ethel and Harold lived most of their lives in Canberra and retired to Narooma in their later years. Ethel died in 1990 and her ashes are interred with Harold's ashes in St John's Churchyard.

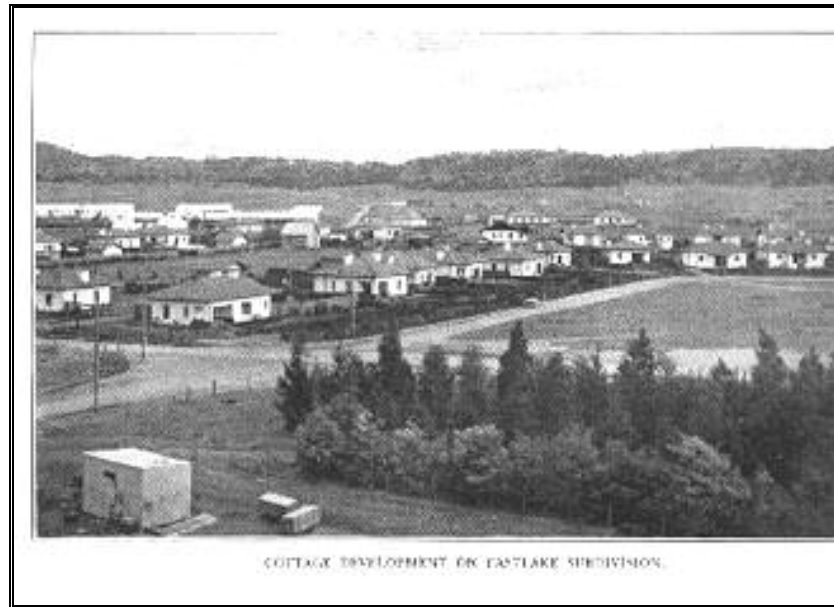
