**CAUSEWAY, CAPITAL HILL & MOUNT AINSLIE CAMPS**

By the end of 1931 only a few official camps remained. They were Capitol Hill, Causeway and a few humpies at Mt Ainslie and Duntroon Camps. In 1947 Capitol Hill Camp was extended and improved to take in the single workmen arriving from around Australia and overseas. During the 1940s the Berry family were the Mess Caterers. The Causeway Camp like that of Capitol Hill was built by the FCC in 1925. It was a cubicle camp erected near the railway station
