

Aerial photograph circa 1926 (Australian Archives CRS A 3560 Item No 1160) loaned by Dr Robert Boden. The Acton Cottages range diagonally across the photograph. Number 12 was known as *The Big House* and was originally built for Mr Breen, Manager of the Bachelors Quarters. When he found that he had to pay rent for the cottage he refused it. Note the building (Hall?) top right with the smaller *little house* on the right of it. One of the cottages is now in River Street Oaks Estate. It is thought to be Mrs Preston's cottage and was one of a few that had a verandah.
