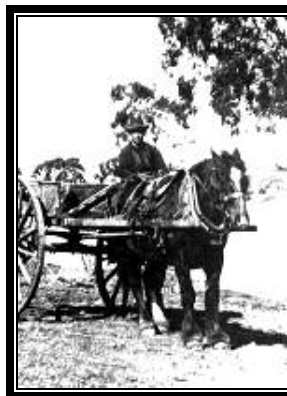

They were often called upon to play exhibition matches against visiting Davis Club players, including such notables as John Bromwich and Adrian Quist. He excelled at cricket and was the best wicket keeper in Canberra for nearly a quarter of a century. From the age of 21 to 44 he played in representative teams for the ACT and Southern Districts. As a golfer he won the Royal Canberra Golf Club's Canberra Cup in 1962 at the age of 60. It was entirely appropriate that in 1996 he was formally recognized as one of the all time greats of*

sporting life in Canberra and accorded a place in the Sporting Hall of Fame.

The family lived at No 2 Westlake and later No 32. the following information was given to me by Patrick (Jr) and his wife Pat. Betty (Bridget Mary nee Stephens) was born 29.5.1905 in Tasmania and came to NSW aged 3 years with her parents, John and Edith (nee Harris) Stephens. In 1925 at Queanbeyan Betty married Patrick Thomas Kinnane born in Cobar 24.3.1905. The newly weds later moved to Molonglo Tenements where William Henry was born. Their next child, a son, Thomas Patrick was born in Sydney where Betty was sent for medical attention. Patrick was followed by John Joseph (born in Horrie Cleaver's taxi on the way to Queanbeyan Hospital from Westlake), Gloria, Keith James and Barbara. On 11 February, 1950 Patrick Jr married Pauline Dominick at St Christophers Church, Manuka. They travelled by 'plane to their honeymoon and on their return lived for awhile with the Curley family at No 33 Hutchins Street, Westridge before moving nine months later into their new home at 31 Hutchins Street where they remained for the next 15 years. Patrick Kinnane (Jr) died in the late 1990s.

to be on the premises of Parliament at all times.¹ Dad had a small vegetable garden in the corner of the Parliament gardens and kept beehives on Camp Hill among the gum trees...Gough Whitlam and I were in the same class at Telopea Park School and I left school to join the Public Service a fortnight after my 14th birthday and worked at Civic. One lunch hour I cycled home across Commonwealth Bridge... I wanted to watch a rehearsal of a parade in front of Parliament House. I was standing with typists, clerks and other folk on the balcony. I could smell tobacco smoke and turned around to see the Prime Minister, Ben Chifley, standing behind me, smoking his pipe. I said, "I'm sorry, Sir, I'm in front of you." He patted me on the shoulder and said, "It's alright my girl, I only came out for a breath of fresh air. I'll see all the parade tomorrow." I have always thought of how typical it was of him as a very approachable Prime Minister. He died in 1951 while Leader of the Opposition.

In 1935 a film was made by Charles Chauvel called "Heritage" and was filmed mainly in and around Parliament House. I was in the film for a few minutes only... In 1937 after living in Parliament House for four years, I left in my bridal gown to be married at St John's Church. I was the first bride to leave for marriage from the old Parliament House.

My husband's Father worked on the construction of the Parliamentary gardens in 1926. My family has had a long association with Parliament throughout the years – firstly my Father, my Husband and my Brother...
