into a brick cottage in Batman Street where they lived for the rest of their lives. Frank Dowthwaite died on 17th September 1943 aged 69 and Isabella died on 20th September 1961. She was born on 5th June 1875.

He joined the AIF and served overseas during World War 1. After the war he married Ethel. Herbert Streatfield died on 9th September 1988 aged 95 years. His ashes were interred in the family grave. Valerie May Streatfield, second child of Ethel and Herbert died on 30th November 1931 aged 10 months. The cause of death was diphtheria.
