family who lived at Springbank and Klensendorlffe farm. His Obituary was printed in the *Canberra Times* on 1st February 1998. *ONE OF NATURE'S GENTLEMEN AND A PROUD CANBERRA FARMER.* Frederick Gordon Kaye's death on December 17 marked the end of an era in the history of Canberra. A third generation Canberra farmer, Gordon Kaye was born on Klensendorlffe Farm (near the site of the Albert Hall) on October 1, 1910, just three months before the Federal Capital Territory was established. He attended the naming ceremony in 1913 and the opening of both Parliament Houses in 1927 and 1988. Canberra was his home and he loved it. He was a true Canberran and proud that, as a farmer he was carrying on a tradition established by his grandfather, Joseph and continued by his father, Samuel Charles also born on Klensendorlffe Farm.

Gordon's grandfather, the first Kaye in the district arrived in Queanbeyan in the 1830s. After some years there in business, which included the establishing the town's first licensed inn in 1838, in partnership with William Hunt, Joseph took up farming in Canberra in 1844 at Springbank. In the 1850s he went back to Queanbeyan but about two years later [1854] returned to Klensendorlffe Farm which originally included the sites of both Parliament Houses. Samuel Charles, born in 1861, took over the farm when Joseph retired to Queanbeyan.

In 1924 the Kayes moved back to Springbank and after Samuel Charles's death in 1933 his widow and a number of his children carried on the farm. Gordon was one of those and he, two brothers and a sister were still farming at Springbank when the development of Lake Burley Griffin forced their retirement. The present Springbank Island was the site of the homestead.

Gordon attended Narrabundah School near where the Forrest Fire Station now stands. As there was no secondary school at the time he spent a year at school

in Goulburn before returning to Canberra when the Telopea Park School opened. He left school in 1925 to become a full-time farmer and milk vendor – something in which he was already experienced having delivered milk from the farm by horse and cart both before and after school. Twice-daily delivery were usual in those pre-refrigerator days.

Modest and retiring, Gordon was one of nature's gentlemen and well-loved by all who knew him. In addition to his basic farming chores he managed the business affairs of the farm and the milk vending which, as Canberra grew, developed into a significant business. Gordon was one of a group of dairy farmers who established the Dairy Farmers Co-operative and, for many years, he was the organisation's secretary. In managing the farm he had to cope with an ever diminishing lease as Canberra and particularly the Australian National University developed and portions of the farm were resumed. Gordon woke at three or four o'clock every day to share the morning milking chores with his two brothers. This seven day a week routine left little time for sport and social activities, but he managed to find time for tennis at Braddon, and after he married, at Forrest. Later he was a keen team supporter of his two sons in their rugby careers. He also found time to pursue his interest in politics and current affairs. He spent many hours at Parliament House listening to debates and as his time was often limited purchased daily copies of *Hansard* so he did not miss anything. From time to time when sufficiently moved, he wrote letters to the editor.

Gordon is survived by his widow Betty, sons Ted (Darwin) and Alan (England), daughter Lorraine (Canberra) and eight grandchildren.

The funeral notice in the *Canberra Times* 19th December 1997 states that Gordon died on 17th December 1997 and mentions the names of his grandchildren – Sharon, Louise, Julia, Michele, Stephanie, Tom, Ben and Larissa.

He was born in Jamestown South Australia, and was educated at Prince Alfred College Adelaide, where he graduated in science and electrical engineering with honours.

In World War 1 he was commissioned with the Royal Australian Engineers, serving in France and Belgium with the Fifth Pioneer Battalion, AIF. After discharge he joined Vickers Armstrong Limited, ship builders at Newcastle on Tyne. He returned to Australia in 1920 when he was employed by William Adams Limited of Adelaide. In 1924 Mr Gray joined the Department of Works and Railways coming to Canberra...(section missing in the printing) assistant electrical engineer. From this time Mr Gray associated with local electricity undertakings and maintained a high standard of construction and scientific investigations required for its development. Mr Gray also initiated the rural electrification programme which has been carried out in the ACT since 1945. He was also responsible for the development of major electrical installations at Darwin and Alice Springs before and during the war years. Prior to his retirement through ill health in 1952 Mr Gray had prepared the ground for the reversion to the Department of the Interior of the Electricity section.

Mr Gray was well-known in Canberra community life, being chairman of the local Repatriation Committee, a post he has held since 1946 and a past president of Legacy. He was a foundation member and former direction of the Canberra Services Club. He is survived by his widow, two sons and two daughters. The funeral will take place at St Andrew's Church on Monday. (St Andrews Presbyterian Church.)

Mrs Francis wearing a black crepe romaine frock and velour hat and Mrs Marriott a smart frock of blue wool georgette with black accessories. The couple left by car for a tour of the south coast.

Mrs Lorna Marriott died in the late 1990s. She generously gave to me many books owned by her family from the 1920s and early 1930s – such as issues of *The Community News, Canberra a City of Flowers* etc. These have been invaluable resource documents well used by me. The couple did not have any children.

K Marriott of Forrest paid for the grave in Woden Cemetery for Leslie Marriott of Forrest who died on 6th January 1937 aged 55 years.

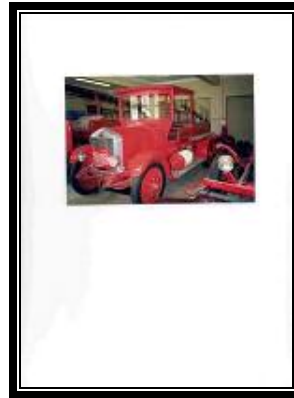


The Canberra & District Historical Society Newsletter No 380 April/May 2000 has an article by Val Emerton entitled *The Power House Cottages, Gone, But Not Forgotten* in which she writes the following:

Percy Douglas and his family have also left their mark on the history of Kingston. Percy was transferred to Canberra from Melbourne in 1913 to take charge of the city's first fire brigade then located in a tin shed at Acton. He too went off to WW1, finding on his return to Canberra in 1919 that his job had been abolished during his absence. However, in 1921 while he was working at the Government Accounts Section and living at the Bachelors Quarters at Acton he was commissioned as Chief Fire Officer and asked to reform the Canberra Fire Brigade and Ambulance service. The new station was opened in 1923 behind the Power House at Eastlake and was made up of series of temporary galvanized iron buildings clustered around the workshops where all the Government vehicles including the first ambulances (operated by firemen) buses and cars were maintained. The hoist for drying the hoses can be clearly seen in early photographs. The following year, 1924, Percy Douglas married a local girl, Una Southwell and for about three years they lived at Briar Farm [1913 the Kinlyside family left Briar Farm and from that

time the place was let to a number of Commonwealth Employees – however this information informs us that at the time the house was owned by Fred Southwell – the Southern Cross Yacht Club is on the site of the old farm house]which belonged to his wife's brother, Fred. While they were there they had two children, Joan and Lorraine, a third child, George was born after they moved to Kingston. Their first Kingston House was on the corner of Giles and Jardine Streets. This house later became the home of local constable Gus Weiss, one of the first Canberra policemen. The Douglas family moved into another cottage, this time on the corner of Telopea Park and Gosse Streets about 1931. They had the first telephone connection – Canberra 1. At the same time six or so other firemen followed their chief into the same block and became part of the little community. The 'Power House Cottages' also became known as the 'Firemen's Cottages'. Fire Chief Douglas and his troops lived in these houses until a week before WW2 broke out in 1939 when they moved en-masse into their new station and residences at Forrest beside the Manuka Oval...

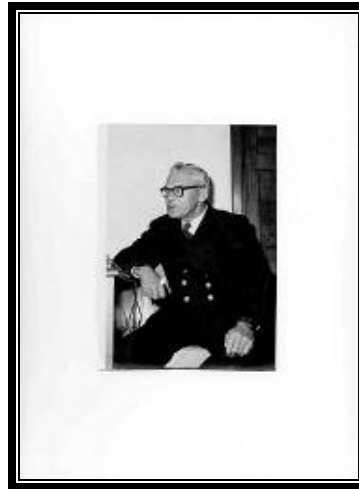

The Woden Cemetery Burial register notes that John Goodwin of 10 Wilmot Crescent Forrest paid for the grave in the Anglican section of Woden Cemetery for Freda Maie Goodwin of the same address who died on 8th August 1949 aged 46 years.
