The 1943 Electoral Roll notes that Charles Fitzsimmons lived at Manuka Arcade. He died on 14th July 1948 aged 69 years. He was a destitute person.

The Operative Painters and Decorators Union paid for the grave in the Anglican section of Woden Cemetery for Archibald Notman of Manuka Arcade who died on 7th October 1948 aged 22 years.
