

Chapter One Outline of Early Families

This book is structured around the Price and Martin families, but include some mention of the other major families that intermarried with them that include, Crisford, Merrick, Bedwell, Clout, Cooper, Chapman, Garbutt, Cattin alias Cattell and Yeo.

The outline of the majority of families in the book in this section mention only the first two generations.

MERRICK

Edward & Mary Elizabeth (nee Russell)

Edward arrived on the *Surprise* in 1790 and his wife on *Mary Ann* 1791. Both were convicts and settled in North Richmond where Edward became a pound keeper and district constable as well as a farmer. When he first arrived in the colony he was one of the blacksmiths.

Edward Merrick born circa 1763, London England. He married 24.12.1791, in St Phillips, Sydney, Mary Elizabeth Russell, born circa 1765, London, England, died 25.5.1840, Richmond. Edward died 9.2.1839, Richmond. On 26.3.1788, Edward Merrick & George Woodward were indicted for stealing.¹ On the 2.4.1788 they were tried at the Old Bailey before Mr Justice Ashurst. George was found not guilty but Edward was sentenced to 7 years transportation to the Australian Colony. It was 26 months before Edward arrived with the 2nd Fleet in the ship *Surprise*. In 1815 he was District Constable & Poundkeeper. Mary was 25 when she was convicted of stealing 1 hank of silk valued at 10 shillings. Mary was tried at the Old Bailey and was sentenced to 7 years transportation. She arrived 10.7.1791 on the ship *Mary Ann*.² This couple became our first ancestors to arrive in Australia. They are buried in St Peter's Cemetery at Richmond.

JOHN MERRICK 2.2.1793-10.9.1874. He married 2.6.1835 to Eliza Francis (1820-19.11.1897) MARY ELIZABETH MERRICK 14.3.1795 – 7.10.1855. She married Robert Martin Jr 13.8.1822. He was born 23.10.1797 and died 11.9.1872.

WILLIAM MERRICK 1796 – 1798 (year not known) and died 29.10.1874. He married 26.12.1823 to Henrietta Blackman 1806-27.4.1851.

JOSEPH MERRICK 22.5.1800 - 17.7.1875. He married 1832 to Maria Jane Wood 11.10.1815-17.8.1898.

RICHARD MERRICK Aug.1802, Hawkesbury River, d. 25.Dec.1887, Branch Creek.

THOMAS MERRICK Aug.1802, Hawkesbury River, d. 7.Apr.1881. The twins did not marry. According to stories heard the boys had intellectual disabilities that may have been caused by lack of oxygen during the birthing process.

SUSANNAH MERRICK 7.1.1812 – 6.10.1894. Susannah had a son, John Waterford by William Waterford born c 1802. On 26.8.1844 she married Thomas Eather born circa 1820 – 25.6.1875. This couple had three children.

COOPER

Charles & Alse (nee Davis)

This couple arrived on the *Barwell* 7th May 1798. Charles, a convict, was on the hulk *Fortune* prior to being moved to the *Barwell*. Alse along with small daughter Sarah boarded the ship 24th October 1797. Charles died in Batavia August 1820 and what happened to Alse is not known other than she had died prior to Charles returning to England in 1817. I suspect she may have died around 1806 and is buried under the name of Ann Cooper? It may be that she had TB?

SARAH COOPER 13.12.1793 – 5.12.1883. She married 1816 to John Moore, convict who was a bricklayer by trade who arrived on *Marquis of Wellington*. One of their children became the Reverend William Moore who worked in Fiji for

many years and was responsible for translating the bible into the native language.

THOMAS COOPER 25.8.1798 Parramatta – 29.10.1805. He drowned in the Parramatta River.

WILLIAM COOPER 1800 – 1822. Nothing is known about William. One wonders if he had TB?

ANN COOPER 21.1.1801 – 15.5.1856 (TB). She married 21.9.1818 to William Price, convict, who arrived on *Ocean* 1816.

MARGARET COOPER 2.7.1803 – 28.6.1806. She fell into a cauldron of boiling water and died.

THOMAS COOPER 12.11.1805 – 13.12.1893. He married 7.10.1825 to Emma Camp Rollinson 12.5.1811-20.12.1889.

MARTIN

Robert & Mary (nee Cooper)

This couple came to Australia as free settlers on the *Experiment*. The ship initially set sail from London 3.12.1803 but was damaged in a severe storm and had to return to Cowes where repairs were undertaken. The ship then set sail on 2.1.1804 but without Martha the 15 year old daughter of Robert and Mary.

Sailing with the couple were their other two children, Robert aged 5 and Caroline aged around 4 months. Caroline did not arrive in Australia and it is presumed that she is one of the children of the settlers who died on the voyage.

The indent indicated that Robert the Elder was 35 years of age and his wife 36. Mary nee Cooper (no relation to those who came on the *Barwell*) died 3.3.1841. On 26.1.1842 Robert the Elder married Margaret Henderson who was born circa 1804. The couple had a daughter, Johanna Henderson Martin who was baptised on 26.6.1842.

Robert the Elder died on 13.6.1842 – his daughter was less than a month old. He left all his personal property to his wife for her life. At the time of his death his only son, Robert Jr was

in his late forties and had run the family properties at Richmond and Cobbora for many years. Margaret Martin married a widower, Stephen Field. She died 23.5.1891 aged 87 years and is buried near her first husband.

CHILDREN OF MARY (nee Cooper) & ROBERT MARTIN THE ELDER

MARTHA MARTIN c1788 – remained in England?

ROBERT MARTIN JR 23.10.1797 – 11.9.1872. He married first to Mary Elizabeth Merrick on 13.8.1822. She was born 14.3.1795 and died 7.10.1853. The family story mentions that the couple eloped. For a number of years Robert was coachdriver at the Governor's residence – Government House Parramatta. The children were all born at Parramatta. Robert married a second time to Mary Oliver Perry who died 11.8.1873 aged 64 years.

- ROBERT COOPER MARTIN 17.11.1822 – 17.10.1884. He married Martha Price.
- CAROLINE MARTIN 19.5.1824-3.12.1878. She married William Thomas Price.

CAROLINE MARTIN 1803-1804

JOHANNA HENDERSON MARTIN
May 1842-5.11.1917. In 1865 she married Crawford Robert Bedwell. He was born 25.1.1842 and died 13.12.1886 aged 44 years. His occupation was auctioneer and the family at that time lived in Glebe in Sydney. The majority of the family, however, were buried in St Peter's Cemetery at Richmond. Robert Crawford Bedwell was the seventh child of Susannah Matilda (nee Ward) and Lieutenant Commander Frederick Bedwell (1796-1856) who came to

Australia in 1817 on the *Dick*. He had in his earlier years taken part in the capture of Washington in the American War of 1812 and one story mentions that he was the *last living connection with the banishment of Napoleon Bonaparte to his island prison of St Helena; and he is generally accepted as having introduced the willow to Australia with cuttings from the tree that stood in the enclosure surrounding Napoleon's grave.*³

Crawford Robert and Johanna Henderson Bedwell had a very large family of whom only a few reached adulthood. One can but wonder if TB was in this family also.

Whether or not Johanna and Robert Crawford Bedwell had any surviving grandchildren is not

known. It is also interesting to note that none of their children have the name *Martin*.

PRICE

William and Ann (nee Cooper)

William Price was born on Christmas Day 1792, son of William and Sarah (nee Smith) Price. He arrived on *Ocean* 30th January 1816. The couple lived at Richmond where in later life William became quite well off.

WILLIAM THOMAS PRICE 6.7.1819 – 20.4.1895. He married Caroline Ann Martin and after her death, Elizabeth Isaacs. (See Martin information)

CHARLES PRICE 13.11.1821 – 12.8.1912. He married Martha Martin. (See Martin information).

JOHN PRICE 8.5.1824-8.7.1893. He married Charlotte Crisford and after her death Elizabeth Jane Robertson.

MARYANN PRICE 18.12.1826-5.12.1875. She married Caleb Crisford.

MARTHA PRICE 8.2.1829-7.9.1913. She married Robert Cooper Martin (see Martin section). This couple settled in Cobbora area.

BENJAMIN PRICE 23.3.1834-5.11.1854. He did not marry.

LYDIA ANN PRICE 1.5.1836 – 15.6.1880. She married Thomas Crisford.

CAROLINE PRICE 25.1.1841-10.5.1891. Single

REBECCA PRICE 15.7.1843 – 21.7.1890.

Charlotte and John in the early years of their marriage moved to South Australia and then Victoria before moving back to Penrith where John founded his undertaking business.

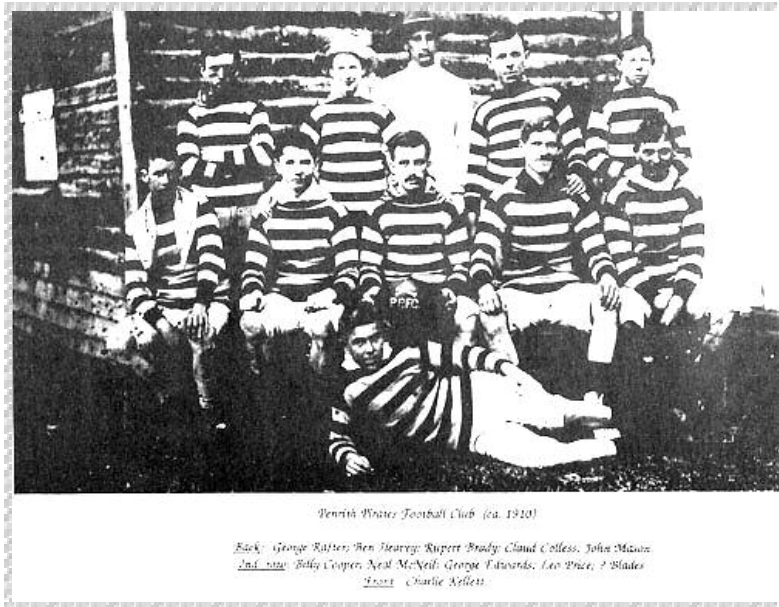

CRISFORD FAMILY

The Crisford family arrived in Australia on 26th October, 1839 on the *Florist*. The family consisted of John Crisford born June 1797 and at time of departure lived at Hastings Sussex; his second wife, Mary (nee Merrick) born c 1809 and children, James born October 1820, Caleb baptised October 1822 and baptised on 7th November 1822 at Sandhurst by Cranbrook Kent; Joseph born c March 1823; Edwin born c 1827; Charlotte born c 1832 and Thomas born April 1836 and baptised 7th July, 1836 at Sandhurst Wesleyan Church. Another child,

Jabez was baptised 2nd April 1835 but did not come to Australia. Edward Crisford may have been born on the way out to Australia and two other children, Martha and Mary (latter born 1847) Martha married in 1860 to James Gow. Martha died 27th December 1907 and her obituary appeared in the *Nepean Times*. It mentioned that she was 66 at the time of her death and was born at Richmond NSW. In 1860 she and her late husband moved to Regentville, then Penrith and later to Summer Hill before moving to St Mary's (near Sydney) where they kept a store. After her husband's death Martha and Mary (Miss Crisford) lived together. There were no children of the marriage. Mary Crisford died in November 1924 and her obituary appeared in the *Nepean Times* 28.11.1924. It mentioned that she was 84 years of age at the time of her death and she is buried at St Mary's Cemetery.

Edward Crisford was born in 1839 and returned to England to take Holy Orders in the Anglican Church in 1875. Prior to leaving Australia he married in 1875 Alice Humphreys. One child was born in Australia in 1878 – obviously before leaving the country. The NSW records mention the following children: Hilda NM 1878; Emma NM 1882, Winnifred E 1886; Harold RB 1888; Wilfred PE 1893. Edward died in 1893. He officiated at a number of family occasions.

John Crisford – trade bricklayer – died 23rd November, 1855 and is buried in the Wesleyan Cemetery Londonderry (Old William Price, his wife Ann (nee Cooper) and their son Benjamin are also buried in this cemetery. It has been neglected and most of the headstones have gone. The family when they arrived settled in Richmond and then on 13th June, 1845 moved to Elizabeth Street Sydney.

YEO FAMILY

The first of the Yeo line to come to Australia was according to oral history jumped ship. He wrote home telling of good land around Moss Vale area with the result that more of the family followed. The first known Yeo to arrive was Roger Yeo and his wife Margaret. They settled in the Bathurst area.

JAMES and ANN (nee Russell) YEO.
James Yeo from Swimbridge in Devon was the patriarch of the family that married into the Price, Martin and Chapman line. He was born on 9.8.1835 Swimbridge, son of John and Alice nee Stribling Yeo. John was born circa 1793 and died 3 months before James' birth. James Yeo arrived on the *James Baines* in 1855. This ship docked in Melbourne where James changed to the *Hellespont* and travelled north to Newcastle and thence on to Morpeth. He died 17.7.1907 and is buried at Cobbora. On 28.7.1856 at Lochinvar he married Ann Russell 30.8.1835-29.8.1913 at Cobbora. She came to Australia on *Cornwell* in 1839. Below James Yeo.

GAR BUTT

There are a number of spellings for this name that include *Garbutt*, *Garbett*, *Garbet*.

William Garbutt was born in the Parish of Glazely in Shropshire arrived in Sydney via Hobart 30.12.1820 on the ship *Maria*. He was put to work for Mr Cox – initially at Mulgoa but later moved to Clarendon where he met his wife, Elizabeth Cattin (Catlin) alias Cattell (Cattle). Elizabeth also came via Hobart – on the *Mary Ann* 3 and arrived in 1823. She married a man with the surname of Callicot (also spelt Collicot). Neither the marriage or death information has been found. By her first marriage Elizabeth had a daughter.

William and Elizabeth married on 28.3.1829 with the permission of the Governor. The

witnesses were John Freebody and Joseph Collins both of Windsor. William and Elizabeth's firstborn, William was born a few months after their marriage. The next child was Hannah born in 1832. She married a man by the name of Watts – no information on him and no record of the marriage. Her second marriage was to Thomas Chapman who came out to Australia as a four year old with his parents, brother and two sisters on the Cornwall in 1839.

Elizabeth and Willam Garbutt's third child was George Garbutt born in 1836. Nothing is known about the two boys. A George Garbett died in 1867 in Bathurst aged 31. This sounds as though he may be *our* George. What happened to William is unknown.

Hannah Garbutt married Thomas Chapman. The couple had eight children. (see Chapman)

CHAPMAN

Thomas Chapman, along with his wife, Mary Ann (nee Clout) and four children arrived in Australia in 1839. They travelled with a number of Mary Ann's family. The extended family came from a number of villages in Kent that included Beneden and Hawkhurst. Thomas was an earthenware man and the Clout families were weavers (descendents of Flemish weavers that came to England in the 15th century.) The industrial revolution affected the living of these families.

Mary Ann Chapman died a year or so after arriving in the country leaving four small children – Sarah, John, Elizabeth and Thomas Jr who was four years old at time of departure from England.

Arthur Cornwall, a Chapman descendent has written a family history.⁴ The following information is from his research. Thomas Chapman married Anne Avery 14.10.1773 Beneden Kent. They had the following children:

Sal Underdown was a minor and had to have the permission of her father. This couple had the following children:

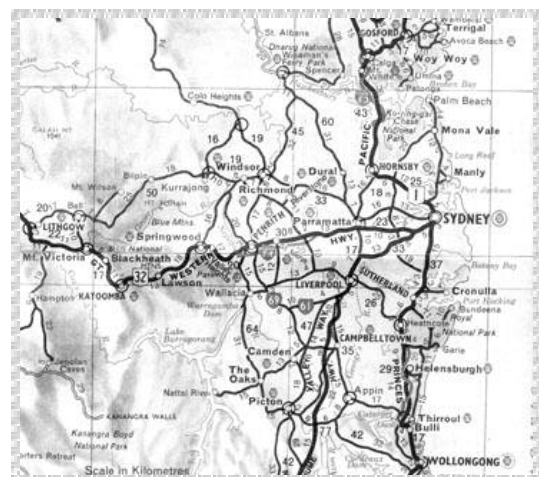

CANBERRA & MY FAMILY.

In 1941 Violet (nee Yeo) and Leonard Austin along with small daughter, Ann, moved from Collarenebri to Canberra where there was work. And it was primarily because of this move away from close family that I, Ann Gugler (nee Austin) decided to find out about my ancestors that resulted in this book.

Following are photographs taken in a Canberra not seen in books on the national capital. We lived at Westlake, one of the hidden working class suburbs erected for construction workers. These suburbs along with the numerous construction camps were not part of permanent Canberra.

The above photograph was taken in 1924. The unfinished cottage on the right is 27 Westlake where my family lived from 1941 until 1959. These cottages were sold and moved to new sites from the mid 1950s. The last cottage was moved in 1965. The site of the majority of these cottages today is Stirling Park in the Canberra suburb of Yarralumla. The sites of cottages 22-62 are in Stirling Park and the sites of 1-20 are now in the grounds of the Mexican Embassy in Yarralumla.

When my family moved to Canberra in 1941 the city was still a mixture of construction camps/settlements and a few scattered permanent suburbs isolated from each other by paddocks still used for rural purposes. The area in the centre of the photograph top right column now is the site of Lake Burley Griffin. The large building bottom centre is the Hotel

Canberra and Westlake was at the end of the track on the left hand side of photograph.

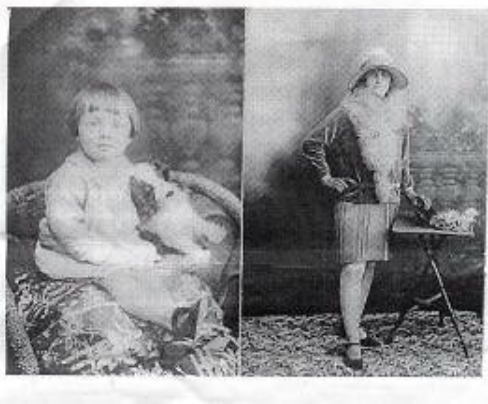
