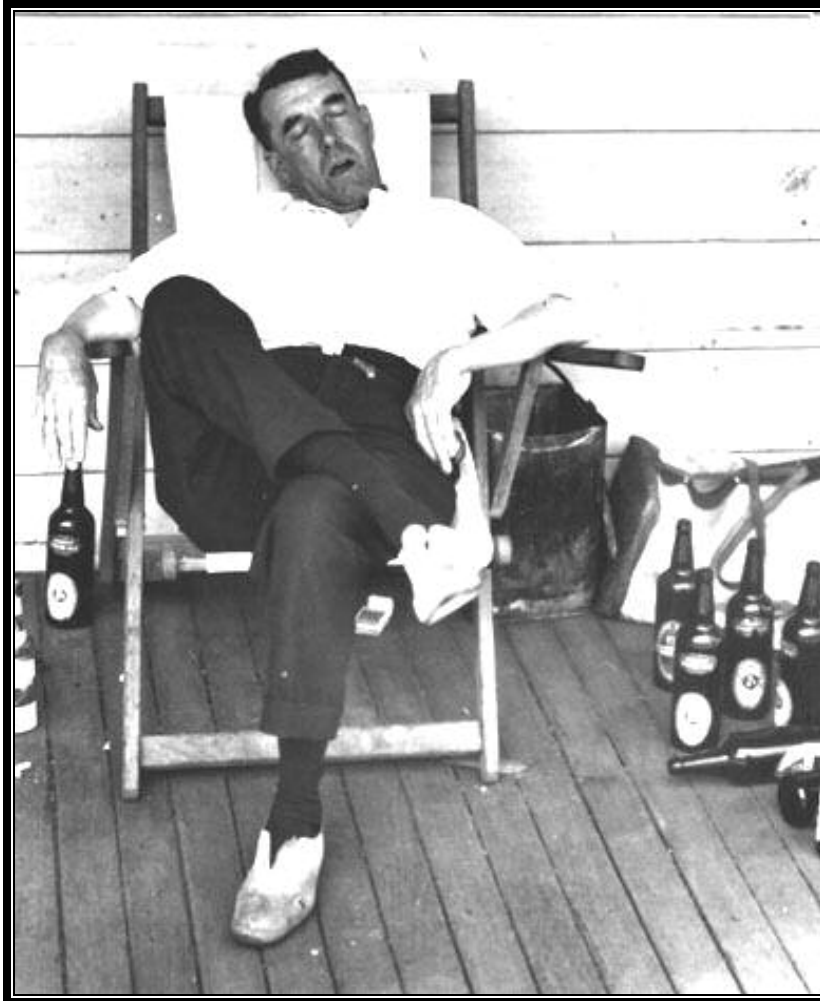

Below: Early Map of the central part of Canberra. Kurrajong Hill was renamed Capital Hill and is today the site of the Parliament House. The Corkhill family moved in the early 1920s to the Yarralumla Dairy and

renamed the property *Riverview*. The Corkhill property on this map is the site of the National Library, High Court etc. C Kaye on the left hand side of map is marked by a tall old pine in Lennox Park. This pine was planted in 1919 by a family member who had just returned from World War 1.
