
CAMPS

The majority of official camps were removed by the end of 1929. However, there were many unofficial camps where homeless people set up a tent or humpie or took over a vacant cubicle. 1935 was still the height of the Great Depression. Capitol Hill and Causeway survived. They continued into the Post World War II years.






