

# Deakin, Duntroon, Forrest, Fyshwick & Griffith Electoral Rolls 1935

## Deakin

This suburb did not develop until the mid to late 1940s. My memories are of three small cottages sitting in splendid isolation. They were easily seen from the old Cotter Road. The cottages were in Young Street - later named *Grey Street*. The first cottages were erected for employees of the Prime Minister.

HELLIER, Emily, Bonn & Lawrence hd, contractor & clerk

A Lillian Hellier was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery on 14th January, 1986 - may or may not be related to the above family.

LOWE, Helen & John hd & labourer

Helen Maree Lowe died on 20th March 1982 and is buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery.

Karlo Baltgalus of 28 Grey Street paid for the grave in Woden Cemetery of Baby Baltgalus who was stillborn on 12th October 1950.

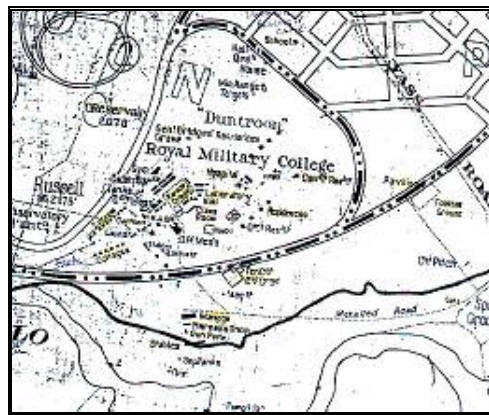


## DUNTROON

In 1930 the Royal Military College moved to Sydney and did not return until the period of World War II. Parts of Duntroon may be the area now called Pialligo. Other parts of Pialligo were called Fyshwick and the area now known as Fyshwick was Molonglo.

**ALDRIDGE, Doris & Harry hd & groom**  
H Edward Aldridge worked at Duntroon as a groom between 22.4.1918-28.2.1931.

**ATKINS, Pricilla hd**

**AXELBY, Elsie & Albert hd & labourer**  
Albert Richard Axelby died on 10th May, 1973 and is buried in the ex-servicemen's section of Woden Cemetery. Elsie Bridget Axelby was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery on 5th April 1960.

**BARBER, Florence & Thomas hd & gardener**  
Florence Barber died on 8th April 1976 and is buried in the Anglican Section of the Woden Cemetery.

**BARRIE, Marguerite & John hd & dairy farmer**

**BRADLEY, Harry concrete hand**

**BROOKS, Frank clerk**  
Frank Brooks died on 27th June, 1969 and was buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery. Violet Dorothy Brooks was buried in the same grave on 23rd February, 1984.

**BUTCHER, Edith hd**

**BUTLER, Lilian & Arthur hd & medical practitioner**

**BYRNE, John salesman**

Two John Thomas Byrne were buried in Woden Cemetery. The first was buried in the ex-servicemen's section on 22nd August 1947 and the second in the RC Section. He died on 1st January 1966.

**CAMERON, Isabella & Walter hd & carpenter**  
A Walter J Cameron was a paymaster from 9.2.1926 to ?

**CAMPBELL, Emily & Gordon hd & steward**  
Emily Jane Campbell of Duntroon paid for the grave in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery for Emily Jane Campbell who died on 15th October 1955 aged 62. She died in the Duntroon Hospital. Mrs Emily Campbell of Duntroon paid for the grave in the

Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery for Gordon V Campbell who died on 23rd September 1943 aged 61.

**CAPSTICKS, Eva & Albert hd & carter**  
Mrs Capsticks worked as a cleaner and cook 13.2.1926-13.6.1928. Albert Capsticks was a steward/labourer 15.7.1913-28.2.1931.

**CARLING, Florence, Arthur & Frederick hd, woodcarter & assistant cook**  
Arthur Carling was buried in the Woden Cemetery. No dates provided. Florence Beryl Carling died on 26th August 1985 and is buried in Gungahlin Cemetery. F Carling worked as a labourer 8.2.1926-10.1.1931. In Woden Cemetery there are headstones with the following information: Arthur Carling died 25th March 1982 aged 75 and Valda Muriel Carling died 29th March 1977 aged 61.

**CARNALL, Mary & Frederick hd & labourer**  
Frederick W Carnall was buried in the Anglican Section of the Woden Cemetery on 3rd March 1947. In the next grave Mary Josephine Carnall was buried on 29th October 1952. Frederick William Carnall worked as a Labourer Storeman 22.9.1915-30.6.1930.

**CASS, Gladys hd**

**CHAPMAN, Ethel, Enid & Benjamin**  
dressmaker, hd & gardener  
B Chapman worked as a gardener between 1.7.1921-13.2.1931.

**COPPIN, Mary Alice & Harold hd & cleaner**  
Harold John Coppin was buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery on 13th January 1962. In the same grave is Mary Alice Coppin who was buried on 2nd November 1959. Date of death not given but her grave along with Kevin's was bought on 16th October 1950. At the time of her death her age was given as about 60. In the next grave is Kevin Coppin who died on 10th October 1950 aged 23. He was buried on 12th October 1950. The address of Harold Coppin at the time of Kevin's death was 68 Macarthur Avenue.

**DIXON, Elsie & Edwin hd & fireman**  
Edwin and Elsie Dixon later moved to Westlake where he died. The couple came to Canberra around 1914. They also lived in the Power House Camp, Eastlake Tenements and Molonglo. Mrs Dixon with members of her family moved to 11 Bentham Street Yarralumla where her son Phillip lived until his death in the late 1990s. The house has now been pulled down (August 2001). On the site a number of new houses are in the process of being built. This is happening throughout this suburb once known as Westridge.

**DUNPHY, Daisy & William hd & caretaker**  
Daisy Violet Dunphy died 30th August 1972 and is buried in the RC Section of Woden Cemetery.

William is buried in the same cemetery in the ex-servicemen's section. He was buried on 7th July, 1953. He died on 15th July 1957 and was 62 years of age. His grave was paid by the RSS&AILA and his address was 20 Booroondara Street Reid.

EDLINGTON, Jennet, Rita, Charles, Harold & William hd, hd, grazier, hairdresser & labourer Alan William Edlington of Duntroon paid for the grave in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery of Baby Edlington who was stillborn on 29th March 1955. Patricia May Edlington of Duntroon paid for the graves of John Harrington who died on 24th September 1953 aged 61 and Esther Mary Harrison who died on 2nd August 1953 aged 55 years. The couple are buried in graves next to each other in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery and their address was given as 31 Dawes Street Kingston.

EDWARDS, Martha & George hd & steward George Thomas Edwards died on 7th June, 1976 and is buried in the Presbyterian Section of Woden Cemetery. G Edwards worked as a groundsman/groom between 20.3.1911-27.1.1931.

FIELDING, Rene & Geoffrey hd & clerk

FOX, Bernard groom Bernard Fox died on 29th June 1979 and is buried in the ex-servicemen's section of Woden Cemetery. B Fox worked as a groom/steward between 9.4.1924-1931.

FOSTER, Charlotte & Adam hd & painter Adam Foster was buried in the Anglican Section of the Woden Cemetery on 26th October 1965. In the next grave is Charlotte Mary who died 13th December 1975. A Foster worked as a painter at RMC between 24.7.1924-11.10.1930.

GRAHAM, Harriet, William & Allan hd, clerk & labourer Allan Shepperd Graham died 2nd October 1991 and is buried in the Gungahlin Cemetery. Harriet Louise Graham was buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery on 25th August 1969. William Akerman Graham was buried in the ex-servicemen's section of Woden Cemetery on 3rd January 1968. Mr WA Graham worked as clerk in headquarters between 26.8.1926-1.1.1931.

GRANT, Annie hd Annie Louisa Grant was buried in Woden Cemetery on 19th November, 1947. She died on 18th November 1947 and is buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery. She was 82 years of age and her address then was 75 Causeway. Mr Alfred Grant of the Ambulance Station Queanbeyan paid for the grave.

He also paid for the grave of Mathew Bernard O'Brien who died on 10th May 1959 aged 71 years. Mrs A L Grant worked as a laundress between 20.11.1917-12.7.1919.

William Joseph Hall of 35 Herbert Crescent (1955) paid for the grave in the Returned Soldiers section of Woden Cemetery for Sydney Charles Hall of the same address who died on 5th September 1955 aged 34 years.

HAMMOND, Daisy & Lisle hd & labourer Daisy May Hammond was buried in the Anglican Section of Woden Cemetery on 13th November 1967. Buried in the next grave on 7th May 1957 is Lylse Ernscliffe Hammond. He died on 25th May 1957 aged 62 years. At that time Lyle Hammond lived at 13 Seventh Street Narrabundah. His grave in the Anglican section of Woden Cemetery was paid by Neville Francis Wallace of 42 Boolimba Crescent Narrabundah. Also buried at Woden Cemetery in the ex-servicemen's section is Lylse Ernest Clifford Hammond who was buried on 30th January 1964.

HAYDON, Beryl, Edna, Charles, Jeffery & Jeffery hd, hd, school teacher, professor of languages & assistant CS & IR Professor JFM Haydon was a professor of modern languages and along with Charles Haydon who was a lecturer in modern languages at RMC. Professor Haydon worked between 1.1.1912-11.7.1917 and Charles Haydon between 11.7.1918-28.10.1918.

## **BOWLING CLUB, FORREST**

This club was founded at Hotel Canberra Bowling Green.



The issue dated January 17th 1927 of *The Federal Capital Pioneer* (Canberra's first newspaper) reported the history of the Bowling Club. It in part reads: *As part of the scheme of providing facilities for the pursuit of all forms of sport in Canberra, the authorities laid down a bowling green in the grounds surrounding the Hotel Canberra...During the summer of 1925-26 as soon as the green was fit for use, a small band of enthusiasts assembled one Saturday afternoon and had the honor of being the first bowlers to play the game in Canberra. Their numbers increased slightly during the season, but the question of forming a club was not at that time taken seriously. On the approach of the season 1926-27, a meeting was held at the Hotel Canberra on 24th September, 1926 for the purpose of considering a proposal to form a club to operate during that season. At this meeting Mr C Francis was voted to the chair, and it was decided to take action for the formation of a club. The following provisional committee was elected:- Sir John Harrison KBE, Mr C Francis, Mr AE Bruce, Mr JH Pike, Mr W Butler, Mr Roy Smith and Mr W H Loughrey...At the general meeting which was presided over by Mr C Francis it was decided that the name of the club should be the "Canberra Bowling*

*Club". The meeting adopted with slight modification, the recommendations made by the provisional committee regarding the occupancy of the green at the Hotel Canberra and the provision of a working scheme for the completion of the formation of the club. It was also decided that the opening day be held on 6th November. The following office bearers were elected:- Patron, Sir John Harrison KBE, president Mr C Francis, vice presidents, Messrs JH Butters Esq CMG, MBE, CH Gorman, W Scott Brownless and Mr HR Waterman; hon secretary and treasurer, Mr WH Loughrey; general committee, Messrs C Francis, JH Pike, and T Hope; green committee, Mr R Reid and auditor Mr GA Crease. The opening of the season was carried out under the most favourable weather conditions, in the presence of about 60 ladies and gentlemen, including Mr JH Butters and Mrs Butters. The first "jack" was thrown on five rinks by the following ladies:- Mrs JH Butters, Mrs C Francis, Mrs HR Waterman, Mrs WH Loughrey and Mrs T Hope...*

Father McGilvray in his book *The Hallowed High Adventure* has written about Mr James Brophy and his family - part of which follows: *A few months before his death on May 24th, 1969 the Canberra Times ran an article about Canberra's Mr Sport, Mr James Brophy. The title was well merited as Mr Brophy had been associated over many years with swimming, hockey and football. He was a life member of the Canberra Amateur Swimming Club since 1947, having joined that organisation eight years earlier. For twelve years he was its President. Since 1939 he had taken a keen interest in hockey and he had occupied executive positions in ACT and NSW Hockey Associations since 1939; and held high offices in the Canberra National Football League. In addition he was Foundation member of Canberra Eisteddfod Society in 1939 and was President of the Australian*

*National Eisteddfod from 1953 to 1969. On his retirement from the Public Service in 1955, Mr Brophy stated, "I saw Heads of Departments died a year or two after they retired, and I decided if I made the top, I would keep busy on something when I retired." This is precisely what he did, and his interest in his many activities remained to the end. Jim Brophy came to Canberra in 1930 and lived in Empire Crescent Forrest, till his death. His father Mr R Brophy who died in 1937 aged 95, lived with the Brophys. In January 1922, Miss Elizabeth Constance Ridley became Mrs James Brophy at Saint Brigid's Church, Red Hill Brisbane. There were six girls and four boys of the marriage and for over forty years the name Brophy has been closely identified with Catholic and civil activity. Father Haydon had a soft spot for "The Brophy Kids" as he was wont to style them. In their school years the ten of them, intelligent, sport loving and lively, were born leaders amongst their younger associates at St Christophers School.
