### GLEBE HOUSE, REID 1943

"Glebe House, designed by Canon A D Soares was built in 1873 on land donated by the Campbells, as a second rectory for St John's Church (the first was the cottage of the pioneer settler, J J Moore at Acton). The rector, Rev P Galliard Smith who lived there from 1873 was the rector of St John's for 50 years and was responsible for many of the plantings around the church and the elms around Glebe. Glebe house has seen many residents, notable amongst these was St Gabriel's Church of England Girls School (1926-1928) and the Canberra Grammar School in 1929. After this it became a boarding house which it remained for the next twenty years. Glebe House was demolished in 1956, but as a reminder the grove of elms remain." Reid by Shibu Dutta The bricks

### HOTEL ACTON

In 1943 the Hotel Acton that opened in 1927 was not used for its primary purpose – accommodation. Because the planned continuation of moves of departments from Melbourne were put on hold following the opening of parliament in 1927 a number of Hotels were not used to capacity. The Hotel Ainslie was leased to the Spendlove family and the Hotel Acton was used as the Patents Office and later used also by the Canberra University College. It is interesting to note that many men and families lived under canvas, small unlined cubicles and in humpies and that using the Hotel to accommodate these people was not considered. Following is an article from *The Canberra Times* 25<sup>th</sup> April 1940 which refers to the Hotel Acton:

*EXTRA PROVISION AT HOTEL ACTON. At the 11<sup>th</sup> annual commencement ceremony of the Canberra University College at the Albert Hall last night, the chairman of the Council (Sir Robert Garran) announced that approval had been given by the Minister for the Interior (Senator Foll) to the College occupying the two front wings and centre block of the Hotel Acton when it is vacated by the Patents Office.*

*Although provision cannot be made yet for resident students, accommodation problems for lectures are solved for the time being. Sir Robert said, however, the Government should not lose sight of the need for a complete University at Canberra at the earliest opportunity.*

*The large audience was addressed by Sir John Latham, Chief Judge of the High Court and Chancellor of the University of Melbourne. The commencement was attended by the Prime Minister and Mrs Menzies, the British High Commissioner and Lady Whiskard, and the Canadian High Commissioner and Mrs Burchell.*

*In an address on 'Australian in Relation to World Development,' Sir John Latham traced the history of Australia's economy founded upon primary industry. Remote in time and space from the rest of the world, Australia found it difficult to appreciate that countries in Europe had lived for centuries in apprehension of attack by an hereditary enemy. Only in the 1914-18 war did Australia begin to realize it was not entirely independent of that world.*

*By its methods of developing by expanding loans on railways and road works in Australia, he said, had developed largely a pick and shovel population. One of the problems of to-day was to give to citizens a chance to become reasonably skilled. A balance should be sought between primary industry and maximum secondary industry development consistent with national welfare.*

*'To produce things we need is prima facie very good,' he added, 'but we are in a world torn by war and the community must seek to produce those things required for public safety. Therefore the development of secondary industries are of paramount importance.' Realizing the need for an extension of teaching facilities in the Science course, the Council had investigated the possibilities of providing tuition in natural philosophy and chemistry, and the question is now being considered by the University of Melbourne, said Sir Robert Garran. Negotiations are also proceeding with a view to providing facilities for*

*teaching in Canberra to qualify for the degree of Bachelor of Education...*

*ACCOMMODATION – Sir Robert said a review of the accommodation available to the College emphasized the utter inadequacy of the present premises to meet the requirements of students and staff. Yesterday he was advised the Minister for the Interior had approved that there be made available for the College the two front wings of the Hotel Acton, together with the centre block and the court upstairs which later on could be turned into three lecture rooms at a comparatively low figure. 'These arrangements should solve the present difficulties of the College as far as accommodation is concerned.' Stated the Minister's letter. 'In regard to the question of providing residence in the building for students in view of the shortage of office space at present existing, it would be impracticable just now to make such arrangements...'*
