Buried in the same grave is Mary Ann Elizabeth Cleaver who was buried on 5<sup>th</sup> November 1968. In the next grave is George Cleaver who was buried on 24<sup>th</sup> September 1938. He died on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 1938 aged 76 years. His grave was paid by Horace Cleaver. Alice Cleaver was Horace Cleaver's wife and at time of writing Horace Cleaver still lives in his Barton Cottage (October 2001).

(Blackall family of Queanbeyan.) Alice Blackall died on 14<sup>th</sup> June 1963 aged 88 years. She was the wife of Patrick and is buried in the RC section of Woden Cemetery. A plaque on her grave is to Helen Joan Blackall who was born on 4<sup>th</sup> February 1917 and died on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2000. Helen Blackall did not marry and for a few years taught English and Ancient History at Canberra High School. She was a gentle lady. I interviewed her in the late 1990s. At that time she lived at 25 Teloepa Park and mentioned that Mrs Eastern designed the house. Her parents were Patrick Blackall and Alice nee Hayes. They married in Sydney in 1901 or 1902. They had a family of seven children, one of whom, Moya, followed her father's footsteps and became a medical practitioner. The children were George, Gregory, Moya, Jack (John), Patricia, Charles and Helen. Moya married a man by the name of Bailey. Dr Blackhall practiced medicine

in Queanbeyan and later built a house in Northbourne Avenue where Moya and her husband lived for some years. The family moved into the Northbourne house in 1932 – the year Dr Blackall senior died. Helen Blackall mentioned that she got a Canberra Scholarship. She attended Sydney University and completed her degree in 1937. Helen returned as a teacher to Canberra in 1952 and in 1953 was transferred to Canberra High School where she remained for three years. She then went to Blackfriars (School of the Air) in Sydney and later resigned to take up a position in the Library Service. Helen's father is buried in Queanbeyan. She was a very shy person who belonged to the Canberra Croquet Club and was one of the people responsible for collecting the history of the club whose home from its beginnings in the 1920s was Hotel Canberra Croquet grounds.
