NOTARAS, Emmanuel kitchenman The Blue Moon Café was the business of the Prowse family. A number of the Notaras family are buried in the Anglican section of Woden Cemetery. They are: Stamazina who died on 29th June 1978, Harry who died on 29th July 1971, Emmanuel buried on 7th November 1982, Helen who died on 13th July 1978 and buried in the Gungahlin Cemetery – John Emmanuel died 11th October 1987 and Frank who died on 25th January 1994. Stamazina Notaras was

born on 16th March 1916 and died on 29th June 1978. Emmanuel Notaras was born in 1896 and died in 1982 and Elini Notaras was born in 1903 and died in 1978. John Notaras was involved in a traffic accident on 12th September 1928 at the time when he had a policeman in the vehicle with him – he was not at fault and was going for his driver's licence. The other vehicle was driven by John McCallum of 39 Westlake who did not have a licence. The body of the report is as follows: *Notaras was undergoing a test for a motor driver's licence in a Chevrolet van type lorry, I was seated alongside of him, the truck was proceeding along Commonwealth Avenue in a Southerly direction and at the intersection of that street with Braddon Crescent, the driver attempted to take a turn to the right, before attempting to do so, he extended his right arm over the side of the car, as the car commenced to turn to the right I noticed a car draw up alongside the front of the truck, I heard a slight crash, Notaras immediately applied the brakes and swerved to the left hand side of the road, both vehicles came to the standstill undamaged. I said to McCallum "What speed were you travelling at?" He replied "Fifteen miles per hour." ...I estimate that McCallum was travelling at a speed of between twenty and twenty-five miles per hour. McCallum, a Fitter's labourer employed by the Federal Capital Commission was working at Black Mountain Quarry, his boss Mr F Scott asked him to go to the Fitters Shop Kingston to obtain certain tools. He has promised to obtain a licence at once... signed by Constable IC Perriman.*
