Sheila Beadman then moved in with Mattie and her husband and died aged 95 years.

Earnest and Annie Beadman who in 1949 lived in Braddon, lived at 42 or 43 Westlake in 1924 and appear in the 1928 Electoral Roll at Westlake. The hill below their cottage was known to many as *Beadman's Hill*. This couple may or may not be related to Sheila and Harold Beadman.

MARTIN, Vera & Arthur hd & teacher Arthur James Martin is remembered in a book by Max Hill entitled A Fabric of Friendship which sets out to tell the story of men's hockey in the ACT. The author states that Arthur was born in Croydon, Sydney and completed his teacher-trainee years at Sydney Teachers College. In 1935 he moved with his wife Vera to Canberra where he took up a teaching position at Telopea Park. At this time he had not played hockey but he was a keen sportsman and played the sports of cricket, bowls and golf. Because

a teacher of hockey was needed Arthur Martin was selected to take the sport with the result that he learnt the sport and under his guidance the sport prospered in the school leading on to the formation of Old Canberran's Hockey Club... He later transferred to Canberra High School when it opened the school opened in 1939 and was persuaded to coach the girls hockey team which did well. Shortly after war was declared in 1939 the RAAF School of Technical Training (2STT) was established near the railway station. These buildings were later used after World War II to house workmen and was known then as Eastlake Camp. Arthur Martin became the chief instructor of the new school and had an intake of 60 pupils that continued for a three month course. Each month a new group of 60 pupils arrived. With staff and instructors there was some 250 in residence...New recruits regardless of their technical expertise on joining up, were all required to complete this course. Arthur remained there during the life of the school. He returned to Canberra High School after the war and was still teaching there during my years of schooling (1949-54) and teaching in the school (1959-60). He was head of the Industrial Arts Section of the school and I never recall hearing him say anything in anger – a gentleman. He had a great sense of fun and along with a few other male teachers was responsible in 1958 for putting me (then aged 20 and a new teacher) up on top of a high cupboard when I dared to enter the men's staffroom. They left me there with legs dangling over the side of the cupboard for any student who came to the door to see.
