

1949 Electoral Roll Molonglo



Molonglo Settlement was established in 1921/1922. The barracks of the Molonglo Internment Camp built in 1918 were converted into 120 cottages and accommodation for 150 single tradesmen. In 1927 the cottages were separated into single dwellings and painted green. The settlement was self-contained with its own bakery, store, and lock-up gaol. Sergeant Cook, the second police sergeant in the territory lived at Molonglo until the lock-up and house was transferred to Acton. From the 1940s the buildings were sold and removed as people were found accommodation in Canberra or left the district. Molonglo today is called *Fyshwick* and *Fyshwick* is called *Pialligo*. There is some confusion during the changeover period and all three *suburbs* should be checked.

20 CHALKER, Lilly & William hd & labourer Lilly Chalker died on 2nd October 1953 aged 44 years. At that time her address was 8 Young Street Barton and her grave in the Anglican section of Woden Cemetery was paid by William James Chalker of the same address.

FRASER, Ada & Roy hd & farm labourer

97 MUNDY, Margaret, Cecil, Leonard & Raymond hd, labourer, mower driver & dairyhand Leonard Clyde Mundy of 62 Scrivener Street O'Connor paid for the grave in the Anglican section of Woden Cemetery for Gary Clyde Mundy who died on 29th January 1964 aged one and half days. Mrs Mary Mundy of Molonglo paid for the grave in the Anglican section of Woden Cemetery for Mrs Mary Mundy who died on 9th May 1949 aged 63 years.
