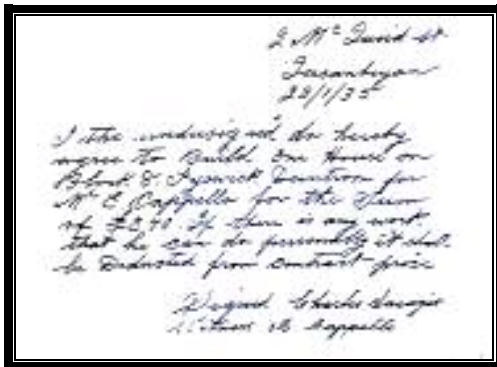

Cappello family was printed. Ermino was usually known as *Harry*. He was born in Cavaso del Tomba and was one of a large family. He arrived in Australia on 26th January 1913 and moved to the Canberra District in later that year. His brother, Enrico – always known as *Henry* came to Australia some fifteen years later.

Towards the end of the First World War Harry returned home to Italy to serve in the army – Italy then was on Britain's side. He returned to Australia at the end of the war and married his Australian girlfriend, Hazel Emma Handberg who was born in Coolgardie. The couple had three children, Veronica Hazel (known by her second name born 23rd December 1918), Regina (died as a baby) and Glen (born 8th October 1923). His wife died of TB in 1925. Glen was looked after by Grandmother (Bridget) and Charlie Sacagio in Queanbeyan. Hazel boarded at St Gregory's Convent School in Queanbeyan. 1928 Harry remarried to Maria Ursula (Nina) Triaca and there were no children from the second marriage. For a time in the thirties the family moved to Sydney to find work. In 1935 they returned and at this time Harry leased Block 8 Fyshwick (now Pialligo) where he had a house built for him by Charles Sacagio Jr.



Harry continued to work at the Brickyards and his farm. He left the Brickyards when someone complained that a foreigner (Harry) was allowed to drive the truck which regularly delivered up to 18cwt of explosives. (He was already a naturalized Australian). He left the job because of the discrimination and took up full time farming – He supplied poultry and fruits to places such as the American Embassy, Chinese Legation, Hotel Canberra, Kingston Guest House, Hotel Civic and the Bachelors Quarters at Acton. He also worked on other jobs such as the construction of the sewer tunnel from near the Archbishop's House on the Civic Side of Commonwealth Bridge to Haig Park Turner and so on. In the 1950s he and his family retired into a house built for him by his son Glen in Captain Cook Crescent. In 1960 he changed his occupation again – this time to timekeeper at the Weston Creek Sewerage Works.

He remained in this job until his official retirement in 1962. He was then presented with a clock inscribed, *To Mr Henry Cappello, a mark of esteem from the Boys Up the Creek, February 1962.*

Harry's brother, Henry worked as an electrician at Mugga Quarry, Staceys of Manuka and finally – joined the Department where he remained for the rest of his working life. He was one of the men who rewired Parliament House. He has two sons, Gino and Frank who still live in Queanbeyan.

Harry's daughter, Hazel, married Giovanni (Jack) Cappello who came from the same village as her father but was not related. The couple lived at Westridge. During the war Jack worked in the Forestry Department at Mt Stromlo. On one occasion Hazel, who had recently given birth to a child was waiting for the bus which left the Prime Minister's Lodge stop (didn't go to Westridge itself) to go over to Acton to register her baby. The then Prime Minister, Mr Curtin, spoke to her and when he discovered her purpose had his driver take her and the baby over to Acton to register and then drove her home.
