Then Dad had lived at the Printers' Quarters near the Kingston shops, while Mum had lived at Brassey House, not far away across Telopea Park itself. Mum even had relatives her: her aunty Ollie (Mrs Olive Lott) who was a great card player and lived near Manuka.*
