

1959 ELECTORAL ROLL CAPITAL HILL and HILLSIDE HOSTELS

Capitol Hill Camp was built in 1925 by Contractor John Howie. It came close to closing in the early 1930s but was kept open along with the Causeway camp. Mrs Stanley ran the Mess from 1928 - early 1930s. During the early post World War II era, a new hostel was built nearby – it was named CAPITAL HILL HOSTEL. The majority of men living in the hostel were *New Australians* who were at that time, unless naturalised, not eligible to vote and thus did not register on the electoral roll.

HILLSIDE HOSTEL 1959

In 1923 No 1 Labourers Camp was built on Capitol Hill in the section then known as Westlake. It was removed in November 1927. In the early Post World War II period Hillside Hostel was constructed on the same site. As with Capital Hill Hostel, the majority of men in this hostel were New Australians and unless they had become Australian citizens are not on the electoral roll.
