THE NAVY IN CANBERRA

H.M.A.S. Harman, the Royal Australian Navy's radio station in Canberra, is Australia's biggest radio transmitting centre. The station is a major link in world naval communications and is capable of keeping in touch with Allied Naval Commands and R.A.N. ships throughout the world.

The radio station is in two sections. The receiving centre is at Harman itself, east of Canberra, on the road to Queanbeyan, while the transmitter station is north of the capital, at Belconnen.

It was communications which first brought the Navy to Canberra. Work on the radio station began in 1938 and it was completed in 1940. It played an important part in wartime communications and was used by the United States Navy and the Royal Navy. During the war it transmitted an average of 180,000 words a day, all of them in code.

The communications centre has continued to develop in post-war years. The powerful low frequency transmitter can provide reliable long-range communications even during sun-spot activity. During Royal Tours, continuous communication has been maintained through H.M.A.S. Harman between Royalty in Australia and Buckingham Palace in London.

Four times a day the Navy transmitter broadcasts an accurate time signal from the Mt. Stromlo Observatory. This transmission is available to world shipping, and has been used by scientists studying the speed of radio signals over long distances. H.M.A.S. Harman is also a relay station in an international seismic warning system. When severe earthquakes set up tidal waves endangering Western Pacific islands, warnings are broadcast from Honolulu to H.M.A.S. Harman and relayed from Canberra to the danger areas.

H.M.A.S. Harman was the first establishment to employ members of the Women's Royal Australian Naval Service during World War II. Today, there are more than 100 Wrens at Harman, making it the biggest WRANS establishment outside of the training school at H.M.A.S. Cerberus in Victoria.

Most of the Wrens serving at Harman are radio operators. Some of the others, such as writers, work at Navy Office, which is situated at the Russell Offices.

Navy Office is the administrative headquarters of the Navy and employs some 700 uniformed personnel and civilian officers of the Department of the Navy. Members of the Naval Board and their staffs are based at Navy Office.
