7 March 1930 Car capsized on Uriarra

Road just passed the entrance to

Molonglo on the Canberra side. Charles

Talbot 63 passenger single, Michael

Henry Cusack single 46 years passenger
and Norman Baldry single 25 years
passenger - all of Printers Quarters. The
owner driver was Anton Hovi Anderson
c/o Arbuckles Refreshment Rooms,
Kingston. Drivers Lic No 98. The
passengers were too drunk to know
what happened. First on the scene of
the accident was Arthur Freeland of
Molonglo. Driver was a tee-totler and
said he was doing 35 mph.

23 November 1929 - collision between

30 November 1929

Accident between a motor cycle owned

24 years. Dunelt Cycle No 282 Lic No
334 - the driver was Thomas Williams of
Corroboree Park Ainslie Lic no
1022...cycle skidded in sand - no action
taken.

5.20 pm 4 October, 1929

Intersection of Bougainville Street &
Furneaux Street Forrest - FCT Chev Lorry
312 driven and owned by Morris James
Gallagher Lic No 2128 of Westlake
Canberra. The other driver of the FCT
Pont car 422 was driven by Mabel
Langford Mapleston Lic no 1747 of
Ducane Street Forrest. Her husband
William Mash Mapleston owned the
car. No injuries and no action taken.

17.9.1929

Mrs Reynolds of Westlake applied for a job for her brother who was single. Her husband had died some week earlier from influenza Her husband had worked for the FCC for a period of 5 years. Her brother was taking over the responsibilities of looking after the family including the small children.
